# **Programmes**

#### **Work Experience**

Together with Ace of Spades Contracting Limited, we tailor packages to suit secondary schools. Trainees undertake a 6 week Taster Course where they go out one day each week and work in one of the crews under the guidance of a qualified trainer/assessor. In addition, work experience students have the opportunity to gain Unit Standards relevant to their chosen operations and credits towards NCEA.

This programme gives students the opportunity to engage with potential future employers, and helps those keen students with a seamless transition into the workforce.

### Courses

Tailor made Unit Standard packages to suit secondary schools careers and gateway programmes. Chainsaw courses, general requirements, basic vegetation fire safety, planting, plotting and navigation.

These packages are also offered to contractors/businesses in the industry sector.

#### 1. CHAINSAW COURSE

Two day course.

Day one consists of theory and basic maintenance.

Day two is spent at one of our training sites where basic chainsaw operation, sharpening and more advanced maintenance takes place. This course is one of our more popular courses in secondary schools, but is also sought after for agricultural and other forestry contractors. Packages can be tailored to suit the needs of the client.

#### 2. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS FOR FORESTRY

One/one and half day course (depending on the number on the course and trainers available). This is a theory based course designed for people starting out their journey in forestry. It is the baseline requirement for entering any forestry operations. It outlines the Health and Safety, Environmental, and Nutritional requirements for all forestry workers.

#### 3. PRODUCTION PLANTING COURSE

One to two day course consisting of both theory and practical. Learners will interpret job prescriptions, work plans, and follow a process to plant trees at the required stocking of a plantation forest. Correct planting techniques will be taught, and learners will need to demonstrate these. This course is popular in the winter months as we have good access to plantation trees and Ace of Spades Contracting's planting sites.

#### 4. VEGETATION FIRE SAFETY

A one day course consisting of both theory and practical. Suited for people looking to pursue a career in rural fire fighting/training, or to be on standby during the fire season for vegetation fires. Trainees will build basic knowledge of vegetation fire behaviour, how to operate portable pumps, and demonstrate knowledge of hand tools and constructing a fireline.

The practical components are scenario based in a controlled environment. Ace of Spades Contracting often provides assistance at vegetation fires. As trainees gain more knowledge and understanding, they are given opportunities to go and help fight forest fires.
